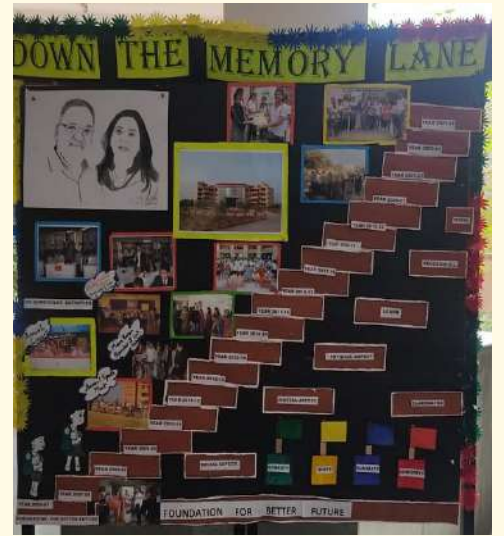

ENGLISH WEEK

Students' language development is integral to their success in every area in school. Language enables students to play an active role in various communities of learners within and beyond the classroom. In order to inculcate linguistic prowess in students, Delhi Public School Harni celebrated 'English Week' from 8 April, 2024 to 16th April 2024. The primary objective behind the celebration of the 'English Week' was to enhance students' explorative thinking skills, sharpen the LSRW (Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing) skills and to learn the correct usage of spoken English. The 'English Week' commenced on 8th April, with a Special Assembly, wherein the students of secondary section presented a short play on 'The Merchant of Venice' (Act -IV; Scene I) by William Shakespeare, to highlight the importance of how words can change a situation in someone's favour. The outside boards of different classes were decorated with different themes for each grade. Standees were decorated with brief sketches and the works of well-known poets and authors. Students participated in a plethora of activities with great zeal and excitement to showcase their interest and love for English Language. These activities had various learning outcomes which enabled the students to – enhance vocabulary, creativity and getting inspiration from the lines of the prescribed poems, learn and co-ordinate with tune and rhythm, pronunciation, stress, correct intonation and to express music sense through musical instruments, foot tapping, beat boxing, clapping, finger snapping etc. These activities also enhanced their writing skill, sentence construction and usage of grammar along with creativity and imagination. Students sharpened their observation skill as well. The students were able to comprehend the content and connect the prescribed poems with the real life situations. Separate assemblies were organized by the Primary and Secondary section to culminate the English Week. Winners were awarded certificates to acknowledge their effort and making it a proud moment for them. The successful completion of the celebration of English Week was attributed to the driving force of the supportive management, constant guidance of the School Principal, inspirational mentoring of the Headmistress, the vibrant and energetic teachers of the English Department and our ever-enthusiastic students.

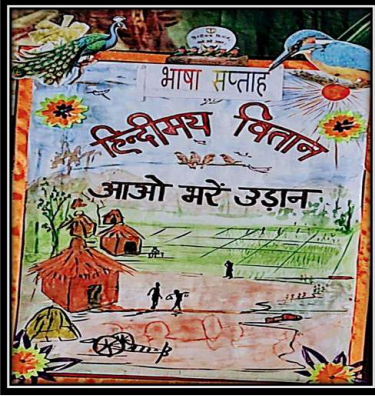

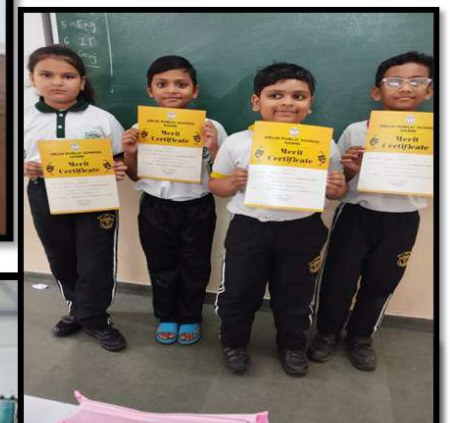
